REQUIREMENTS FOR ADMISSION TO THE TOWSON UNIVERSITY BUSINESS MAJOR Students are admitted to the major in Business Administration (BUAD) on a competitive basis after first being admitted to the University. Admission to the University does not guarantee admission to the major. Each term, the College of Business and Economics (CBE) considers applications for admission to the major in the following term. For admission, students must:

- Apply for and receive formal admission to TU as a degree candidate; transfer application deadlines are:
 - **Transfer in Fall:** apply by Dec. 1 (Priority and Scholarship) or Regular deadline of Jan. 15;
 - **Transfer in Spring:** apply by Oct. 15. www.towson.edu/admissions/undergrad/transfer/
- Cumulative GPA of 2.00 or higher for all course work (for transfer admissions, a 2.5 or higher is usually preferred).
- Grade equivalent of 2.00 or higher in each course required for admission to the BUAD major
- Minimum average GPA of 2.70 for ALL of the courses required for admission to the BUAD major:**
 - ACCT 201 or 211 Principles of Financial Accounting (3 units) = **MC ACCT 221 Accounting I**
 - ECON 201 or 203 Microeconomics Principles (3 units) = **MC ECON 202 Econ II**
 - ECON 202 or 204 Macroeconomics Principles (3 units) = **MC ECON 201 Econ I**
 - LEGL 225 Legal Environment of Business (3 units) = **MC MGMT 201 Business Law**
 - ECON 205 Statistics for Business & Econ (or MATH 231 Basic Statistics) (3 units) = **MC BSAD 210 or MATH117**
 - MATH 211 Calculus for Applications (or MATH 273 Calculus I) (3 units) = **MC MATH 150 or MATH181**

No more than two courses above may be repeated, of which no more than one course may be repeated twice.

Please note: *BSAD 111 Personal Finance and STSU courses are not transferable to Towson. All MC General Education courses will transfer without question, for other electives, check ARTSYS for elective course transferability <http://artsys.usmd.edu>
