





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

This agreement is effective with new school admits beginning in spring, 2017.

This agreement will be reviewed biennially and it will expire after five years.

ENROLLMENT AGREEMENT

Montgomery College (MC), a community college in Montgomery County, Maryland, and York College of Pennsylvania (YCP), a four-year school in York, Pennsylvania, agree to the following Enrollment Agreement.

PURPOSE OF AGREEMENT

This Enrollment Agreement will set expectations for administrators, faculty and staff at both institutions and foster a working relationship between the parties.

ADMINISTRATIVE PRINCIPLES

The following general principles guide the operation of this Enrollment Agreement:

MC students who meet the following qualifications will receive guaranteed admission to YCP. MC students can transfer up to 75 credits to YCP. Students may utilize this Enrollment Agreement if they:

1. Complete an Associate's Degree (or at least 60 credits) prior to transferring.
2. Have a cumulative 2.0 GPA or higher.

AGREEMENT BENEFITS

1. YCP will offer on-site advising at MC at least once a semester on each MC campus.
2. YCP will offer instant decisions to MC students with official transcripts and/or a credit evaluation during on-site advising visits.
3. YCP will guarantee admission to MC students who earn an associate's degree.

AGREEMENT PROVISIONS

1. This agreement becomes effective on the date set forth on the first page of this document. One semester, or six months' notice, must be provided in writing should either party wish to terminate the agreement. The institutions will work together to provide information for students currently using the pathway.
2. The office of record for institutional partnership agreements at YCP is the Office of Undergraduate Admission. The office of record for agreements at MC is the Office of the Senior Vice President for Academic Affairs.
3. This agreement represents the entire and integrated agreement between the parties and supersedes all prior negotiations, representations or agreements, either written or oral. The Enrollment Agreement will be reviewed biennially; the agreement will expire after five (5) years unless otherwise renewed. This agreement may be amended only by written instrument signed by both parties.
4. Both institutions agree to abide by all State of Maryland and United State of America laws and adhere to FERPA regulations.
