

DUAL-ADMISSION PARTNERSHIPS

RN-to-Bachelor of Science in Nursing University of Maryland School of Nursing (UMSON) and Montgomery College (MC)

General Program Information

- The UMSON Dual-Admission Partnership RN-to-Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) program is available to eligible students once they are accepted into MC's nursing program.
- Admission into the dual-admission RN-to-BSN is competitive and requires an overall GPA of 3.0 or higher in all undergraduate courses and a minimum 2.75 science GPA (Human Anatomy and Physiology I and II, Microbiology, Principles of Chemistry I).
- If you meet the qualifications, you will be both enrolled as an associate degree student at MC and provisionally admitted to University of Maryland School of Nursing (UMSON) as a Dual-Admission Partnership student.
- After being accepted into the Dual-Admission Partnership program and while enrolled as an associate degree student at MC, you have the option to begin taking RN-to-BSN classes at UMSON.
- Upon completion of the Associate of Science in Nursing at MC and the required prerequisites for the RN-to-BSN program, you will fully matriculate into UMSON to complete the BSN degree through the RN-to-BSN program; you are required to pass the NCLEX exam by the end of your first semester at UMSON.
- To receive the UMSON BSN degree (120 credits), you will transfer in 59 prerequisite credits, receive 30 credits for your nursing license, and take an additional 31 credits at UMSON.

MC grants ENGL 101 credit for an AP English Language and Composition score of 3; however, the minimum accepted AP score for UMB SON must be a 4 – therefore, either take ENGL 101 at MC, or take ENGL 102 and ENGL 103, or ENGL 102 and one from ENGL Literature/Creative Writing.

**Full matriculation into UMSON occurs upon successful completion of AS degree and maintenance of ≥ 3.0 GPA.

Time to complete the BSN will vary depending on number of courses completed by time of AS degree completion and whether student attends UMSON full time or part time. If student has completed UMSON courses while enrolled in MC nursing program (up to 20 credits may be completed), it is possible to complete the AS degree and have only one semester of UMSON courses (11 credits) to complete for the BSN once matriculated into UMSON.
