

Setting Testing Expectations with Students

Testing Area:

- Lighting in the room must be bright enough to show the test taker's face and the surrounding area in a clear and detailed manner.
- Test takers should be seated at a desk or table. Laying down in bed or elsewhere when taking the exam is not allowed.
- Test takers should clear their desk or table of all other materials (e.g., books, papers, notebooks, calculators, etc.)
- Test takers must show the work area as well as the entire room during the room scan.
- No visible writing on the desk or walls is permitted.
- All third-party programs and windows (websites, Excel, Word, etc.) on the testing computer must be closed before logging into the proctored test environment.
- Loud music, television, or other distractions playing in the background are prohibited.
- No other people or parties aside from the test taker is permitted near the testing environment, and all communication between the test taker and other people is prohibited.

Testing Behavior:

- Test takers must not leave the room during the testing period at any time or take the computer into another room without Honorlock's permission.
- No breaks will be permitted.
- Use of hats, hoodies, headsets, or earplugs is prohibited.
- Cell phone use is prohibited.
- The test taker's face must remain within view of the camera at all times.
- Honorlock will not add additional time for proctoring questions or technical issues encountered during the exam.



Setting Testing Expectations with Students

Before Starting

- 1. Have a valid photo ID ready.
- 2. Use Google Chrome with the Honorlock extension installed.
- 3. Test your webcam, mic, and internet before starting.
- 4. Use only one monitor; close all other tabs and apps.
- Contact Honorlock support if you experience technical issues.

Testing Area

- 1. Sit at a desk or table in a quiet, well-lit room.
- Keep your face and surroundings visible on camera.
- 3. Clear your desk of all materials.
- 4. Show your entire workspace during the room scan.
- No other people, pets, or distractions nearby.

During the Exam

- 1. Stay in view and in the same room for the entire test.
- 2. No breaks, phones, smart devices, or external tools.
- 3. No hats, hoodies, headsets, or earplugs.
- 4. Do not use AI tools, chatbots, or unauthorized websites.
- 5. Do not talk, read questions aloud, or record exam content.
- 6. Contact Honorlock support if you experience technical issues.


Side Angle Camera



The side-angle camera can be used for **high-stakes exams** where test takers must show their work or have external resources available.

- Must be enabled at the institution level
- Enabling this option will require an External camera or webcam device
- Can use their smartphone as a webcam

Overview

What It Secures Against


- Virtual machines and remote desktop tools






